Responsibilities

Directs, coordinates, and manages the advanced technology development, outreach, training, and technical aspects of FISTA activities to ensure successful BlueHalo interface with Fort Sill/Lawton community reporting to the SVP of the Army Solutions Business Unit. Identifies opportunities for growth and recognized as the BlueHalo point of contract for the Fort Sill/Lawton community.

Directs, develops, implements, publicizes, and administers operations strategies and objectives to ensure the achievement of FISTA's goals and objectives. Directs the operations function in conjunction with business growth, introduction of new operational systems, meeting organizational financial objectives, and meeting organizational goals in relation to safety, quality, and timely delivery of products or services. Assists with development of organization's capabilities, policies, practices, and attainment of operating goals, while maintaining some management responsibility. Assesses and assists in upgrading the management talent base within

the FISTA to achieve growth and meet market needs. Collaborates across the corporation (Defense, Labs, and Intelligence/Cyber Sectors) needed support to the FISTA through intrasector interface for smooth workflow and cost-efficient product or service. Contributes to the overall short- and long-range planning process and in the establishment and assessment of the organization's annual operating budget. Plans, prepares, controls, monitors, and forecasts organization's direct and/or indirect budgets. Directs the capital expenditure and asset redeployment activities. Ensures attainment of efficient and economical performance in relation to profit and year-end goals. Participates in the investigation and implementation of new services, production operations, and product or systems technologies to meet the organization's objectives. Establishes, implements, revises, and maintains policies and procedures related to operations. Oversees compliance of established policies.

This position will be responsible for maintaining and creating new customer and client relationships to increase business and revenue throughout the Defense Sector and company. They will also need to be skilled at creating new and impactful business relationships with other industry partners for key opportunities. This leader should be familiar with and help promote the business unit's strategic growth and program execution in numerous communities, with a particular focus on Lawton/Ft. Sill community. This person should have familiarity and experience working Congressional actions.

This position will also be responsible to help direct and aid applicable business development, capture, and proposal team members towards keeping current business and winning new business. This role is also expected to expand the ASBU and Defense Sector's customer bases to include cross sector growth and achieving company growth goals, promoting customer satisfaction, and fostering strong customer strategic relationships.

Qualifications

- This position will be in Lawton, OK and candidate must be present or willing to relocate.
- Candidate will have a Bachelors' degree (or equivalent additional experience).
- Candidate must have an active security clearance; however, exceptional candidates with the ability to obtain the appropriate level of clearance will also be considered.

- Have knowledge and understanding of Air and Missile Defense systems and concepts
 including Directed Energy, Counter Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS), virtual training, and
 associated operations, design, modeling and simulation, testing, instrumentation, and
 other key aspects of this area.
- Candidate will have in depth experience with Army AMD programs, processes, and operations.
- Candidate must have a proven positive leadership record.
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing is essential.
- Candidate should: 1) be extremely organized with strong multi-tasking and time-management skills, 2) have experience as part of a cohesive team and be able to deliver the highest quality service, 3) be able to handle sensitive information with the highest degree of integrity and confidentiality.

- Master's Degree in any STEM or leadership/management field.
- Candidate must have experience with understanding DoD contracting and acquisition processes.
- Candidate will have experience managing programs.
- Candidate will have in depth experience with Army Fires programs, processes, and operations.
